

Driving directions to Desert Journeys

St. Mark's/Deanery 6 Joshua Tree Lent Day in the Wilderness

Note that while we depart "together," it's not necessary to stay together on the highways to or from Desert Journeys. We'll share cell numbers at the parking lot to allow keeping in touch.

From St. Mark's: East on E 16th St. to N Campus Ave.

Left on N Campus Ave to I210 East.

East on I210 until merging with E I10 in Redlands

(From the greater L.A. area, if not meeting at St. Mark's, east on I10 or I210 to Redlands, or east on 60 to Beaumont then east on I10)

East on I10 to the Whitewater Rest Area for a brief meet up and rest stop. Then continue east on I10 to Highway 62 North. If the Rest Area is closed, we'll skip the meet up.

(If a restroom stop is needed, there are facilities in the Morongo/Cabazon area. Otherwise, if found closed, the closest restroom facilities are in the travel stops off I10 at Indian Canyon Dr. past Highway 62.)

There is not a convenient return to the Rest Area if you miss the exit. If you should miss the rest stop or stop elsewhere, please let us know so we don't wait for you at Whitewater.

Continue on Highway 62 North/East through Morongo Valley, Yucca Valley and Joshua Tree. At just over 7 miles past Park Bl. (the main road to the Park entrance) and about a mile past Copper Mountain College) turn right on Que Pasa Lane. (There is a wrought iron cross just past Que Pasa and if you get to Indian Cove, you've definitely missed the turn.)

Follow Que Pasa to Sullivan Rd and turn right. About 200 feet west on Sullivan Rd there is a drive on the left leading to Desert Journeys. **Other roads, while on the maps, can be soft sand.**

Reverse to return home. We don't stop as a group at Whitewater on the way back.

(There are supplies in the communities on Highway 62 if needed but it may be best to plan on bringing everything you might want with you.)
