

# Hunger Strike Solidarity Toolkit: Take Action Between Now and Independence Day

*Speak up for the well being and independence of our immigrant neighbors*

Over 100 people are on hunger strike near us at the Adelanto ICE Processing Center and Desert View Annex. The Hunger Strikers are drawing attention to inhumane conditions such as: lack of medical care, dirty water, moldy food, forced deportations, and retaliation in solitary confinement. There are now threats to transfer the Hunger Strikers to El Paso, Texas to remove them from their support systems and legal networks — and to silence their voices.

Take these two actions:

- 1. We are asking you to use the time you would spend eating to take at least one of the actions below to help amplify the voices and demands of detainees at Adelanto.**
- 2. We are asking you to take the money you would spend on a meal that you forego (or what you'd spend for a week of meals) and send it to the Commissary Fund. See the link below.**

Sample Call Script: Hello, I am calling to demand that no retaliation, punishment, or harm be directed toward the individuals who are peacefully protesting and exercising their First Amendment Rights inside the Adelanto ICE Processing Center and Desert View Annex. They have the right to raise concerns about conditions of confinement, and their safety and well-being must be protected. Please stop them from being transferred away from their support networks and legal counsel just to silence their voices. I am also asking you to hear and meet their demands so that they can have safe and humane conditions inside the center.

From inedible food to non-existent medical care - these claims were all verified in a recent report by the California Attorney General. We urge you to set up a visit to Adelanto and Desert View to take note of the horrendous conditions and meet with the hunger strikers to support their demands. Please also investigate the retaliation that they are experiencing and put an end to the cruelty of ICE

& Geo Group who are now threatening to transfer them to another facility in order to silence their demands. Thank you

 **CALL & LEAVE A COMMENT IN ATTORNEY GENERAL ROB BONTA’S PORTAL**

On May 15, AG Rob Bonta released the 2026 Immigrant Detention in California Report which highlighted the “Cruel, Inhumane, and Unacceptable” conditions in the Adelanto facilities. Make a call to AG Rob Bonta. Urge him to further investigate the Adelanto ICE Processing Center and the Desert View Annex and end all retaliation against the Hunger Strikers and listen to their Demands.
