## **Health & Community Protocols for Worship**

**Those 12 & up show proof of vaccination and those 2 & up wear a mask. Unvaccinated 12 & up join us online/in-spirit.**

**During January, please consider getting the booster & social distancing. Also, during January, we will be singing less but still have music, outside for hospitality/coffee hour but still have socially distanced refreshments, and avoiding full-blown in-person sit-down meals (like Annual Meeting Brunch) but still be church and community for one another and the world.**

St. Mark's cares for the young, elderly, and vulnerable. Vaccinations are essential to create a safer and healthier workplace and worship space for all - including employees, volunteers, guests and especially for children, elderly, and the vulnerable. Our health and strength are intertwined with one another - health is not an individual endeavor.

**Masks are worn at all times by those 2 years and up. We strongly recommend the use of disposable (aka surgical/medical/paper) face masks. Cloth masks should have a filter or disposable paper mask underneath. Please avoid single-layer cloth masks with gaps, valves, vents, or other openings.**

Social distancing: We are respectful of those around us and adjust as able for healthy spaces between households. We appreciate everyone's patience and flexibility.

Direct physical contact with young children is avoided; elbow bumps are fine, but no hugs or handshakes.

For the "peace exchange," everyone's space and sensitivities are respected. When someone offers their elbow, fist, or a peace sign, we respond appropriately.

Restrooms: If it can wait, only one person or household uses the restroom at a time.

Hospitality: To reduce multiple handling of shared objects such as the coffee urn, hot water dispenser, and serving utensils, we let the hospitality host serve us. For January, we will be outside.

### **Introducing BREEZE – Our New Church Management Software**

Hooray! We're finally moving into the 21st century and upgrading to a new church management software called **Breeze**. This system is easy for everyone to use—you, the clergy, our staff, and donors. It will allow you to view and update your own profile, to change contact information when necessary, and to view your own pledge contributions. Don't worry! All your information is secure, and your contributions cannot be seen by anyone but a couple of staff who handle the church's finances. If you are a leader of a group, committee, or guild, you will be able to manage a list of your members, set up volunteer schedules, and send reminder emails and texts. Watch for an email from St. Mark's inviting you to set up a **Breeze** account online, which you can do from your computer or phone. Soon we hope to have all our membership information updated, so we can communicate with everyone more effectively.
