#### Move to Stage B when:

· Government issued "Stay at Home" orders lifted



- Working with in-building returned equipment
- Small number of staff on site
- Process equipment returned prior to shutdown
- · Determine plan for sanitizing of gear
- Determine plan for operational changes for clients & staff

## Move to Stage C when:

- · Provincially required protocols in place in each facility
- Business allowed to operate under any Provincial Health Orders



Preparatory Operations and Improvement Projects

- Preparing all equipment to be "Rental Ready"
- · Staff levels as required
- Prepare all equipment for rental
- Communicate plans to clients
- Implement plan for sanitizing rental equipment
- Implement operational changes

# Move to Stage D when:

- Larger scale film production allowed by province
- · New sanitizing protocols operational



Light Operations

- · Serving limited volume of shows
- Staff levels as required
- Open for business to clients at a limited volume, by appointment only, with adjusted operating procedures in place

## Move to Stage E when:

• Cross border travel restrictions from/to US relaxed to suit filming needs



Full Operations

- Normal volume operations
- Full staff on site

• Normal operations with adjusted operating procedures in place

### Move to Stage F when:

- · All government issued restrictions lifted
- Effective vaccine available for use in Canada



Unrestricted Full Operations

- Normal volume operations
- Full staff on site

Normal operations with relaxed adjusted operating procedures in place
