SUMMER CAMPS 2023



Fantastic Photography FULL 3 July - 7 July

This week teaches campers the basics of photography. Each day has a different skill focus with the children travelling the island from east to west to practice and take pictures, exploring places such as Tom Moore's Jungle, St George's, Dockyard, and Cooper's Island. Afternoons are spent playing games in the garden, crafting with nature, and campers will create an exhibition of their work.

Climate Change Agents 17 July - 21 July

This week is spent looking at the causes and impact of climate change. Campers will learn about renewable energies and explore the vital role mangroves play in Bermuda's ecosystem. Activities include building and using solar ovens, visiting Grape Bay to collect ocean plastics with KBB, designing and constructing model eco-homes, and creating useful objects out of trash!

Wild Things! 7 Aug- 11 Aug

Have fun exploring Bermuda's most beautiful nature reserves and open spaces. Participants will enjoy a week of healthy outdoor fun on Bermuda's beautiful trails, beaches, and nature reserves. They will learn about natural history, heritage and field skills while hiking, scavenger hunting and exploring together. Activities at our education centre at Waterville will include crafting with nature, eco-printing and games.

Pirates, Boats and Forts FULL 21 Aug - 25 Aug

Set sail on a journey into the past as we learn about famous pirates, their dastardly deeds, and their adventures on the high seas. From galleons and brigs to sloops and man-o-war's, we discover what made pirate ships so difficult to catch. Venture east to explore forts and learn all about shipwrecks and treasure with a visit to BUEI. Afternoons will be spent designing and creating pirate ships, building forts and more!

Dirt Diggers 10 July - 14 July

Spend an exciting week learning the basics of archaeology, including plotting and mapping, metal detecting, digging, dating artefacts, and recording finds. Visit the BNT's new archaeology lab in St George's and explore the test pits dug in the spring. Hop over to Smith's Island to visit Bermuda's very first settlement! Afternoons are spent visiting the latest exhibitions from around the world, crafting ancient artefacts and undertaking team challenges.

NEW Update and Create 24 July - 28 July

Turn your trash into treasure and help save the planet! This week campers will be learning the art of upcycling, transforming old clothing, belongings, and trash into new and exciting creations! Make bags, belts, cushions, and accessories. Old t-shirts turn into plant holders; shoeboxes, elastic bands and straws become amazing pinball machines. Join the camp where creativity has no limits!

NEW Myths & Legends 14 Aug- 18 Aug

Campers will time travel to the past as we explore the myths and legends of different peoples around the world. Delve into Roman, Greek and Norse mythology; take an ocean voyage with superstitious sailors and sea-monsters – from China to Peru we explore the strange and mysterious. Campers will be creating their own myths, making fantastical creatures, and using natural materials to build a dragon's den in the garden!

NEW Raiders of The Lost Artefact FULL

28 Aug - 1 Sept

Mystery and adventure await campers as we travel the island in search of The Lost Artefact. We will visit museums, historical sites, exhibitions, and landmarks to fact-find, solve puzzles and hunt for clues. This week will absorb campers in Bermuda's natural and cultural heritage, developing critical-thinking and teamworking skills, all while learning and having lots of fun!
