



How to Get Free Home COVID-19 Tests

Over-the-counter rapid tests sold online or at pharmacies are an easy and fast way to see if you are infected with COVID-19. You can now get these tests for FREE from the federal government or through your health insurance provider. It's a good idea to keep some on hand so you have them when you need them.

covidtests.gov

- » Order up to 8 free home tests online at covidtests.gov or by calling 800-232-0233. The tests will be mailed to your home.

Health Insurance

- » If you have health insurance through an employer or marketplace, your insurance will pay you back for 8 home tests each month for each person on your plan.

Medi-Cal Rx

- » Each Medi-Cal beneficiary can go to participating pharmacies (medi-calrx.dhcs.ca.gov) and show their Medi-Cal Benefits ID Card to get up to 8 home tests covered each month.

Medical Expense Reimbursement

- » Home COVID-19 tests are eligible for payment or reimbursement through flexible spending arrangements (health FSAs), health savings accounts (HSAs), health reimbursement arrangements (HRAs) or Archer medical savings accounts (Archer MSAs).

When to Use a COVID-19 Home Test

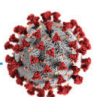
- » You have COVID-19 symptoms, such as fever, cough, shortness of breath or fatigue.
- » You were exposed to someone with COVID-19.
- » You are planning to attend or have attended a large indoor gathering.
- » To end isolation or quarantine.

If You Test Positive

- » Stay home for up to 10 days & follow isolation instructions (bit.ly/covid19-patients).
- » Tell people you have been in close contact with that they may have been exposed.
- » Contact your healthcare provider to see if treatment is available.
