Age / Grade

Students currently in 7th-10th grades will be considered.

Attendance

Class attendance at all sessions is **required** for successful completion of the Academy. Emergencies happen and in the event of an emergency, please contact us at your earliest convenience.

During Class Time

Academy members will:

- Obey the instructions of the instructor, firefighter, or officer in charge during class time and all demonstrations.
- Use all safety equipment provided to help avoid injury to myself or others.
- Be respectful and accountable to classmates, all staff personnel, police and fire buildings, equipment, and city vehicles.
- Place electronic devices on silent or turn off during the class.
- Work together to achieve common goals during demonstrations and presentations.

Dress Code
