Robotics



Carroll Robotics teams are in the midst of their VEX Tipping Point competition season with all 15 teams striving to qualify for the State Tournament on March 5th. Currently 5 teams are qualified for State! Our school will host their next tournament at CHS on February 12th with spectators welcome.

At the state tournament in March, teams will be competing for a spot at the VEX World Championship, which is being held in Dallas this May!





Rockets

In Rockets I, students are researching and designing their I lb, 1 mile rocket using a program called 'RockSiM.' Students completely design and build their rocket from scratch, using only the guidelines in the 'Flight Readiness Review (FRR),' a document that includes any and all requirements/restrictions to ensure a safe launch in Aprill

Students are given a budget to purchase materials from approved vendors and are tasked with procurement, construction, any necessary machining of parts, and final assembly.

Students in Rockets II are currently working on the construction phase of their Transonic Rocket. In addition to passing the FRR, students in Rockets II must perform three component tests on their rocket. Students determine what components they want to test, design a controlled experiment, and produce a report with their results.

Examples of component tests are pressure testing of an altimeter, force testing of components (parachutes, airframe, fins, epoxy, etc.), and verification of recovery system operation!

Principles of Engineering



Our POE students are finishing up the Statics Unit with the Bridge Designer Project. Students have to design and build a bridge that can withstand the weight of a truck safely travelling across it, all while staying under budget!



Once they finish this project, students will move to the projectile motion unit with catapults!

Civil Engineering & Architecture

CEA Students are continuing work on the Affordable Housing project. This project has the students working with a client on the design, sketching and creating in Revit, and completing the project by building a 3D model of the home.

Some of the students are utilizing the Fusion Laser Engraver/Cutter for their models.




PHS students are completing the Fashion Unit, and will next begin working with the Civil Engineering & Architecture class on Interior Design Vision Boards in the month of February!


