CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF UNITY VILLAGE

On June 27, 1919, Unity founders Charles and Myrtle Fillmore purchased 58 acres of rolling woods and meadows from Warren W. Thurston of Lee's Summit. About 15 miles southeast from Kansas City, Missouri, the area grew from a weekend retreat of tents and ponds into Unity Farm.

Today Unity Village is its own township, covering 1,200 acres with two lakes, trails, and the largest fountain display in the region. The Unity Tower and the Education Building are on the National Register of Historic Places, and the grounds feature award-winning rose gardens.

Under the cupola, the Silent Unity prayer ministry answers more than 1.4 million prayer requests per year. Unity publishes *Daily Word*, the award-winning *Unity Magazine*, the award-winning Unity Books, and our Unity

Outreach booklets. Unity Online Radio, in the tradition of Charles Fillmore, broadcasts daily from the iconic Tower.

For a century, Unity workers, constituents, and guests have described Unity Village as home. Here they have gathered to connect, pray, and to cocreate a more peaceful and abundant life for themselves and for others.


This year, as you turn the pages of your calendar, you will find beautiful images of nature and our historic campus. In addition, you will find a section of historic pictures of Unity Farm and Unity Village as we celebrate 100 years.



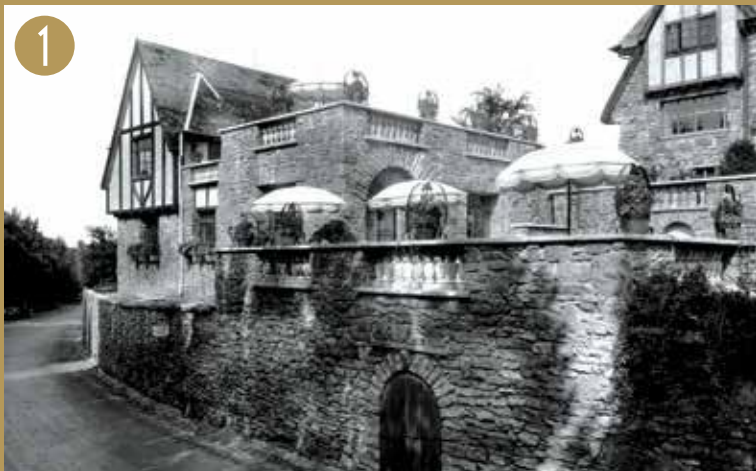

1 TERRACE TEA ROOM

The Terrace Tea Room adjoined the apartment complex during Unity Farm's early years. Here was a beautiful dining room and the outdoor terrace shaded by trees and a delightful surrounding. Visitors enjoyed vegetarian cuisine served cafeteria-style. Fountain service was also provided. The Terrace Tea Room was a premier visitor attraction to Unity Farm. Positioned next to the Unity Amphitheater, the Terrace Tea Room serviced opera-goers before, during intermission, and after performances.

3 FIRST TWO BUILDINGS

This aerial photograph shows the first two major buildings constructed on the Unity Farm. Next to the iconic Unity Tower is the original Silent Unity Building. Both were dedicated in 1929. In the foreground, work has begun on the lengthy water feature and the grading in preparation for the Administration Building. Construction operations were halted during the Great Depression and then continued after World War II. In the background, cultivated fields for farm produce can be observed.

2 CLUBHOUSE

This is an early photograph of the Unity Clubhouse still under construction. The structure replaced an old mess tent used by workers and residents as a gathering place. According to the October 29, 1921, *Unity News*, the Clubhouse was "to provide clean, constructive amusements such as parties, dances, baseball, golf, tennis, hiking parties, and nature study, for the workers of the Unity School of Christianity and their friends."

4 AERIAL DRAWING

The original design was for Unity Farm to become a city. This drawing of the master plan, prepared in 1926 by Rickert Fillmore while working with the architectural firm of Elmer Boillot and Jessie Lauck, proposed eight major buildings serving various purposes. The master plan's construction was not completed until 1989, some 24 years after Rickert's passing. Eventually, all eight buildings in Rickert's plan were constructed in the exact locations he designated.





5 **FRUIT STAND**

Unity News on September 1, 1923, referred to this as the “huckster stand.” Located at the main entrance of Unity Farm, workers sold fruits, vegetables, and field crops. Close inspection shows that milk sold for \$.17 per quart. Unity Farm was best known for its wide variety and high quality apples from its orchards. Ice-cold cider was a specialty.

7 **POTTING SHED LIGHTS**

Workers completed this small structure in 1922 to serve as the home for John Royal Fillmore, the third son of the Unity founders. Unfortunately, Royal Fillmore made his transition on September 9, 1923, a year after construction. Adorned in Christmas lights, the structure eventually served as a farm office for Royal’s older brother Rickert, a studio, and later became known as the “potting shed.” This was one of the first four buildings on the farm to have telephone service.

6 **TOWER AND GATE IN 1947**

Completed in 1929, Unity Tower is the most iconic structure at Unity Village. At 165 feet tall, its design was inspired by the Tower of San Marcos in Venice, Italy. In 1935, workers added a carillon. Its original purpose was to serve in part as a 100,000-gallon water tower for the Farm. This photograph, which includes the Unity entrance, was taken in 1947. Unity Tower is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

8 **ARCHES**

Using an English Cotswold architectural style, Rickert Fillmore designed this home for his mother and father, Myrtle and Charles Fillmore. Constructed in 1924, the porch’s distinctive architectural design prompted its familiarized nickname, “The Arches.” Their comfortable home did not have a kitchen. This was Myrtle’s idea because their home was to be a place of rest and relaxation. Besides, Mother Mary Georgiana Fillmore, who lived across the driveway, had a kitchen and did the cooking. A kitchen was added many years later.
