### Meeting Venue



### Venue location

Centrally located, at the entrance of a large hospital area, 50m from the landmark Orthodox Church of Saint Sava in Belgrade, largest in the Balkans.



### Currency

The official currency in Serbia is the Serbian Dinar. Exchange rate for Euro is normally around 1 Euro= 117 Serbian Dinar.

Official Exchange Offices are easy to find in Serbia (Menjacnica in Serbian - look for the sign). Rates offered by the Menjacnica are better than those available in the banks, hotels or on the Airport.



**All major credit cards are accepted.**

### Transport from Belgrade airport to city center

#### By taxi

On arrival at the airport, order an official (and priced: 25-30 Euro) taxi from the desk in the baggage hall and ignore the taxi touts outside.

Taxi prices in Belgrade: Start is 270 dinars + 100 dinars per 1 km

### Public bus

Minibus line A1; Route: Airport – Slavija Square (Kralja Milutina Street) – Airport; ticket price - 400 dinars OW (on the bus); **approximate travel time - 30 minutes**

### Transport within Belgrade

Belgrade has network of trams, buses, and trolleybuses. All forms of public transport use the same ticket which you buy on the newsstand.

Single ticket - cost 89 dinars, 1 day ticket cost 250 dinars,

Be sure you always validate your ticket because they do check riders' tickets often.
