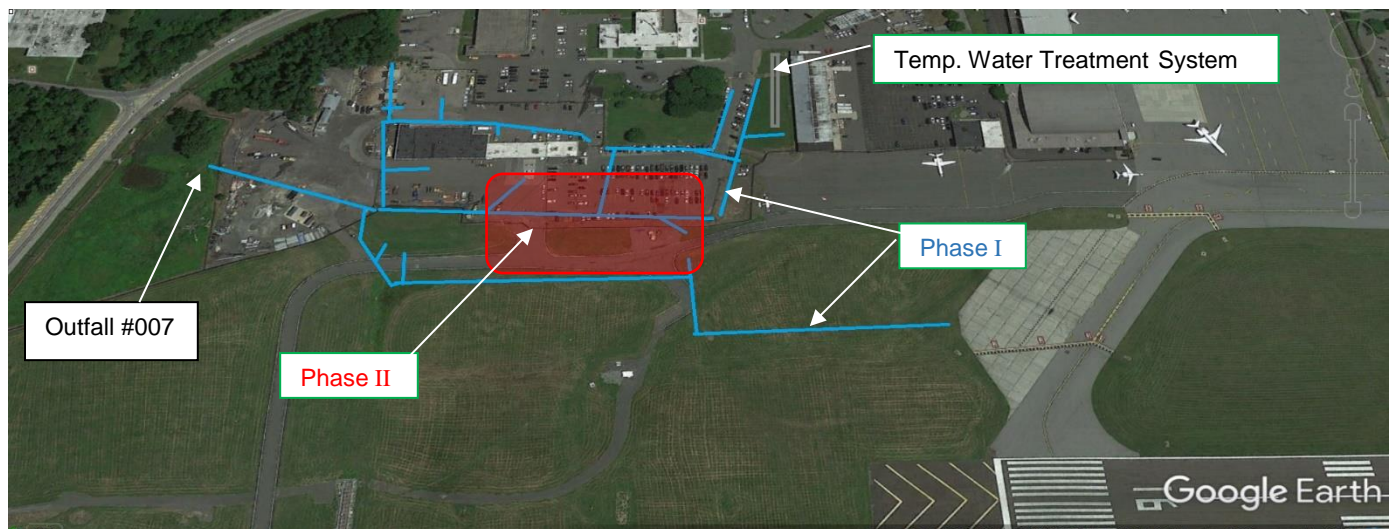
Storm Water Environmental Upgrades - Outfall #007

Beginning on Wednesday, April 28, 2021, the airport will commence the Storm Water Environmental Upgrades of Outfall #007 Project. Completion of this Two Phase project is expected by November of 2021 and work crews will be operating daily from 7 am to 4 pm with heavy equipment in both the North Complex Area and adjacent airfield operating area. We caution all vehicles travelling through the construction zones where work crews and equipment will be protected by signage, flagmen and barriers.

This project is designed to eliminate the existing and deteriorated storm water system piping and structures that are providing a pathway for Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) that were found in the groundwater that enters the damaged storm water system flowing into Outfall #007 and Rye Lake. PFAS were used in firefighting foam during the time period when the Air National Guard was operating (pre-1984) at the airport. New replacement system is designed with materials and construction methods that will make it watertight and resistant to groundwater inflow. Please note that during construction, any groundwater that is encountered in open trenches and excavated areas will be collected immediately and transported to a Temporary Water Treatment System located adjacent to the north side of Building #3. Additionally, during both Phase I and Phase II, portions of the Overflow Vehicle Parking Lot will be closed for use. Phasing dates and construction work are as follows:

Phase I (Blue) April thru August 2021: Demolition old existing storm water system piping and structures and installation of new materials.

Phase II (Red) August thru November 2021: Excavate and remove contaminated asphalt, turf and soils, haul in and install clean fill and full restoration of turf and paved areas.
