The Westchester County Airport is committed to achieving excellence in environmental protection by integrating environmental values into airport activities.

Under our Airport Environmental Management System (AEMS), we are introducing the Sumped AvGas Program (SAP) to reduce or eliminate any unnecessary discharge of fuel into the environment. It is important to recognize the AvGas contains tetraethyl lead, which is classified as a hazardous waste. The Sumped AvGas Program will take full effect on June 3, 2019.

We are seeking your assistance in making this a successful program by disposing sumped fuel properly during all pre-flight inspections. Any waste fuel disposed on asphalt surfaces will result in the deterioration of pavement, causing the release of stone fragments. These fragments pose a threat as they may cause Foreign Object Damage (FOD) to aircraft.

A SAP program brochure outlining sumped AvGas procedures is attached to this bulletin for your review and records. Additional brochures will be made available at the customer service centers at Million Air and Ross West in the coming weeks.

Airport personnel will oversee the SAP program and are available to help tenants comply with the program. Again, our effort will ensure our continued compliance with our environmental responsibility.
