**Immunization Requirements 2022-2023**—Immunization information for *kindergarten* and *new students* was included in the enrollment packet. Parents of 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> graders, you have received letters by mail regarding the immunizations in bold.

As your child completes these immunizations, please mail, email, fax or drop off a copy of the vaccine record to the school office. Please have this completed by the first day of school.

**CHIRP (Child and Hoosiers Immunization Registry Program)**—The Indiana Department of Education requires immunizations for grades K, 1, and 6 to be entered into CHIRP. More information is given regarding CHIRP on the website under the “health/nurse” section. Parental permission must be granted before a school nurse can enter the information. The CHIRP permission form only needs to be signed once while your child is a student at BCS.

**Medication permission forms** are to be completed for each medication that your child needs administered at school. **Please send medication in its original container.** Information on the website also includes forms for students with asthma using inhalers, allergies requiring an Epi-pen and/or Benadryl, and diabetes. *When you completed the updated health form in PowerSchool, you would have given permission for acetaminophen (generic Tylenol), antibiotic ointment and hydrocortisone cream to be administered.* If you prefer your child have ibuprofen, please complete the medication form and provide the ibuprofen. The link for the PowerSchool instructions to access this required form is on the button below the nurse’s letter in the constant contact.
