## AFRICA

---

At the current time, Mali does not have church closures. However, the leaders of the churches have decided to minimize church activities. Pastor Debora asks us to join in prayer for the Lord to bring spiritual awakening to Mali during this period of crisis.

In Ethiopia, the churches are closed for at least one month. This shutdown is impacting pastors who are finding it difficult to provide food for their families. Superintendent Mekebib requests prayer for the resources to provide food for the pastors' families.

Praise the Lord for the ways leaders in Liberia and Ivory Coast are adapting their ministries to the current restrictions in their countries. Pastor Maho, in Liberia, says, "I encourage the village brothers by phone calls, we organize ourselves for prayers in houses like the primitive church to keep the life of God in us."

## ASIA

Pray the Father will provide many open doors for the gospel as Free Methodist leaders in several Asian countries distribute rice and try to meet urgent needs caused by the virus crisis, shutdowns, and job losses.

Pray specifically for two new believers recently baptized in a Creative Access country in SE Asia. Ask God to give the leader in this country courage and clarity to know how she can reach many others with the gospel.

Drilling on two new wells in [Myanmar](#) is scheduled to begin in May. Pray the work can proceed, and the funding will be fully secured.

## EUROPE

Praise the Lord! Pray, they will unite together in prayer for one another and care for each other's needs during this time of crisis. Due to a lack of internet access in places, some houses of peace are unable to meet. Pray leaders in these areas will be encouraged and find new ways to keep in contact.
