Reports are that people in [Nicaragua](#) cannot go outside of their homes. Many in [Haiti](#) are saying the current crisis is worse than anything they have seen. In [Creative Access Country -X](#), the situation is still dire. Now there is a widespread protest planned in [Colombia](#) on November 21, and it is feared there will be violence. Please keep praying for Latin America. God can transform individuals, groups, and even governments.

MIDDLE EAST

Please pray for prisoners in the [Middle East](#) and those leaders who are sharing the gospel with them. Pray for the leaders to have wisdom as they teach these violent offenders about the love of Jesus. Pray prisoners will have their hearts turned toward God, who wants them to know of His salvation and redemption.

FMWM FAMILY

Free Methodist World Missions give thanks for the life of Mary Taylor Previte, daughter of former Free Methodist missionaries James and Alice Taylor. James and Alice Taylor served in China from 1926-1946 and in Taiwan from 1953-1967. Mary's great-grandfather was James Hudson Taylor, founder of the China Inland Mission. Mary died on November 16 as a result of injuries she suffered when she was struck by a car on her morning walk earlier this month. During WW II, she and her siblings spent four years in a concentration camp separated from their parents. As an adult, Mary served as a teacher, the director of a Juvenile Detention Center, and as a state legislator in New Jersey. A memorial service will be held on December 4 in Haddonfield, NJ. Please be in prayer for her family.
