AFRICA

Also, pray for the newly established partnership with [Tumaini Women Kenya](#) where they can learn from other women leaders and expand their training platform.

Continue to pray for the developing ministry of the [Wesley Missionary Institute](#) and the ongoing efforts to establish the funding for operations, which includes scholarship assistance for ten students. Pray that God will use this place to effectively train many cross-cultural workers to be sent out in West Africa.

ASIA

Recently, we asked you to join in prayer for the persecuted church. We also invite you to give praise to the Lord for how He is working in countries where the gospel cannot be shared freely. This week there are reports of 20 new ministerial candidates in one creative access country in [Asia](#). Another creative access country reported 66 new believers were baptized on November 4, and in a different region of the country, 69 new believers were baptized on November 8. Pray the Lord will continue to pour out His Spirit and empower the believers with boldness to share the good news of Jesus.

Please continue in prayer for one of our female pastors in Asia who was recently diagnosed with Stage 3 cervical cancer. Pray for a miracle of complete healing.
