AFRICA

The doctors ruled out typhoid and malaria. They are currently treating him for an infection. Please pray for the doctors to know how to treat him and for his complete restoration to health.

ASIA

Although [Tim Kinkead's](#) surgery to remove his thyroid went smoothly, doctors discovered Tim has stage one thyroid cancer. The next step is radioactive iodine therapy. Since it is only stage one, the radioactive iodine will be the lowest dosage. The treatment will take place sometime between June 8 to 12. Pray for God's peace for Tim and Lily and for the treatment to bring healing and wholeness to Tim's body.

The cost of food had already increased by 50%-75% in the past year, and now it is going even higher. Please pray for Haiti as the number of cases of Coronavirus is rapidly rising.

In late February, doctors found Laurie had a localized but aggressive form of breast cancer. She underwent surgery in mid-March and began radiation treatments this past week.
