

FEBRUARY PRAYER GUIDE

01 ➤ Wednesday | Ethiopia

As a prolonged conflict in the north of Ethiopia seems to be coming to a peaceful resolution, growing unrest in the south is putting pressure on some FM churches. Pray leaders will persevere and stand firm in the face of challenges.

02 ➤ Thursday | Thailand

The FMC in Thailand will hold its annual meeting this week. Pray leaders will be refreshed and inspired. Ask the Father to give clear direction and a fresh vision for planting churches.

03 ➤ Friday | Portugal

The FMC in Portugal celebrated its 22nd anniversary in December. Thank the Lord! As they move forward, ask the Lord to give them a fresh vision and passion for the lost.

04 ➤ **Saturday** | Argentina

Pray for missionary Andrea Tinsley as she transitions from Medellín, Colombia, to working alongside Rodrigo and Tanya Tosado in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

05 ➤ Sunday | Middle East

As people of the majority background experience the love and forgiveness of Christ, pray they will respond with forgiveness for those who have mistreated them.

06 ➤ Monday | Mali

Praise the Lord for new believers baptized in December! Pray for the spiritual growth and discipleship of these new believers and the continued development of leaders in Mali.

07 ➤ Tuesday | Creative Access Asia-MR

The crisis in this nation continues to deepen. Many children are out of school. Pray for our churches as they provide education and health care for local and refugee children. Pray for the children who need safety, education, food, medical attention and basic supplies.

08 > Wednesday | Creative Access Europe-P

Many in this nation are suffering the repercussions of war in another region. Pray Jesus will be made known to all, including those in authority. Ask the Father to bring peace and restoration.

09 ➤ Thursday | Bolivia

Pray for a peaceful resolution to the socio-political conflict paralyzing the country. Ask the Lord to protect the churches and use them as agents of peace and restoration.

10 ➤ Friday | Middle East

Hany and Joanne will travel to Egypt for the birth of their baby girl around March 1. Ask God to give them safety in travel and a smooth delivery of a healthy baby. **Birthday: Hany**

11 > Saturday | São Tomé and Príncipe

Pray for the development and training happening through various discipleship ministries with children and youth.

12 > Sunday | Creative Access Asia-IA

Pray the Lord will provide clear pathways and a shared vision as FMC-Asia works through the affiliation process with a small group of churches in this country.

13 ➤ Monday | Spain

Ask the Lord to provide the necessary resourcing, including finances, materials and personnel, for the Mosaico Cultural Center and the John Wesley Theological Seminary.

14 > Tuesday | Middle East

Join Dawn in praying that she will listen well, go where God directs her, and not be distracted and busy doing other things. **Birthday: Dawn**

15 ➤ Wednesday | Brazil

Praise the Lord for the beginning of a new school year at the FM seminary, where Dan Owsley is the academic dean. Pray for the faculty and administration as they prepare students for fruitful ministry and discipleship in the church. There are currently 108 students enrolled, and 97 are Free Methodists. **Birthday: Dan Owsley**

16 > Thursday | ICCM

Pray God will provide resources and supplies to renovate the House of Love in Cambodia. This ICCM ministry facility needs some renovations as soon as possible.

17 ➤ Friday | Africa

Pray God will open pathways to establish Free Methodist work in new countries in 2023. Pray specifically for potential work in Burkina Faso.

18 ➤ Saturday | Creative Access Asia-MY

Doors of possibility are opening to relaunch a Free Methodist ministry in this country. Pray for the needed resources and leadership. Ask God to give wisdom and discernment in the process.

19 ➤ **Sunday** | Romania

Thank the Lord for our connection with a compassionate ministry in Romania, *Vis de Copil.* Pray for the development of the FMC and the establishment of churches across Romania.

20 > Monday | Colombia

Pray for missionary Shane Jewell as he transitions to the role of VISA coordinator (short-term mission trips) for Latin America.

21 > Tuesday | Liberia

Pray for the annual conference in Liberia as they experience a leadership transition. Ask the Father to give wisdom and unity.

22 > Wednesday | Haiti / Portugal

Haiti: Violence and political instability continue to plague Haiti, making the needs of the people even more desperate. Pray for a miracle of God's peace to come upon this nation. **Birthday: Dan Snyder**

Portugal: Pray for international missionaries Eduardo and Cindi Angelo. Ask the Lord to renew their strength and continue to guide them as they work in Portugal and beyond.

23 > Thursday | Set Free Movement

Pray for Set Free leaders in Creative Access Country-IN who diligently work tracking down young boys and girls who have been trafficked, bringing them back to the safety of their homes and family.

24 > Friday | Ukraine

One year ago today, Russia invaded Ukraine. Pray believers will persevere with faith and be light amid the suffering and destruction.

25 ➤ Saturday | Sri Lanka

Pray the gospel will reach nearly 35,000 villages in Sri Lanka with no Christian contact. Pray for the Canadian General Conference as it invests efforts here.

26 ➤ **Sunday** | Uruguay

Praise the Lord! In late 2022, a VISA work team made progress on the parsonage in Durazno. Pray construction can be completed early this year.

27 ➤ Monday | Sierra Leone

Pray for Pastor Mbawa as he works to develop a small but solid core of Free Methodist leaders and a healthy network of churches.

28 > Tuesday | Greater Filipino Network

Pray for a growing network of Filipino workers throughout Asia who are being organized and connected through FMWM-Asia and missionary Dr. David Clemente.
