Covid-19 Instructions for Visitors to Campus

Due to Covid-19, concerns for your health and well-being, and an increasing number of people returning to campus, Clearwater Central Catholic High School has established guidelines for employees in their workspaces and visitors to campus. **Every visitor must always check in at the front office before going anywhere else on campus.** Below is a list of health-monitoring questions that you will be asked to honestly answer each time you visit campus. **If any of your responses are yes, you are asked to please stay home** for the safety of others. **Additionally, all employees in our schools and guests will have their temperature taken when entering the school building to ensure that it's within the normal range, which is below 100.4.**

Please be advised that these protocols could quickly change depending on the Covid-19 situation in our county. These protocols will be in effect until further notice.

Visitors will be asked to check in with a driver's license to receive a visitor badge.

In addition to self-monitoring your symptoms, please continue to:

- ✓ Wash your hands often, and for at least 20 seconds.
- ✓ Avoid touching your face.
- ✓ Practice social distancing by staying at least 6 feet away from other people.
- ✓ Cover your coughs and sneezes with the sleeve of your shirt or coat.
- ✓ Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects in your workspace often.
- ✓ Consult your doctor if you have a fever, cough, and shortness of breath.
- ✓ Wear a mask unless you can socially distance (6 feet apart) in these other places.
- ✓ Remind people politely if they are coming too close to you or others.
- ✓ Use hand sanitizer when on campus.
- ✓ Wear a mask when in meetings where you are unable to be at a safe distance from others.
