SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR SENIORS

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATION IS FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2023

The following scholarships are available to members of the senior class. Applicants must be a graduating senior in good standing at Clearwater Central Catholic High School, i.e., **have a solid disciplinary record, good attendance record to include minimal unexcused tardies, early dismissals and present in school on unsanctioned senior skip days.** The student must also be on track with the CCC service hour requirement.

MSGR. DEVINE'S FULLY ALIVE SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000 – 1 scholarship) Msgr. Devine will award his \$1000 Fully Alive Scholarship at the end-of-the-year Mass to a graduating senior who exemplifies St. Irenaeus' words "The glory of God is man fully alive, but man fully alive is man glorifying God." God receives external glory when humans are truly alive, presumably alive in God. The only way to truly be yourself, a created being, is through and for the One who created you.

Be a practicing Roman Catholic actively involved in his/her parish
Have an overall weighted GPA (Grade Point Average) of a 3.0 or better

ERIN KAY FLATLEY SPIRIT SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000 – 1 scholarship) is in honor of Erin Kay Flatley a 1996 Clearwater Central Catholic High School graduate who passed away in 2002. Additional criteria:

Have an overall weighted GPA (Grade Point Average) of a 3.0 or better
Have a financial need as determined by FAFSA

PAUL R. PERROTTA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$1200 – 1 scholarship) in honor of Paul R. Perrotta a 1983 Clearwater Central Catholic High School graduate who passed away in 2012. Additional criteria:

Be a practicing Roman Catholic actively involved in his/her parish – parishioners from Espiritu Santo Catholic Church will be given priority.
Have an overall GPA of a 3.0 or better
Show an interest in majoring in Accounting or Business.

EVELYN OSTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$10,000* – 15 available scholarships) Ms. Evelyn Oster, a longtime member at St Justin Martyr Parish in Seminole, Florida, established a scholarship fund to help graduating Catholic high school students achieve high academic goals. The initial \$5,000* awarded may be used for Summer Session, if needed, or for the Fall Semester but not both. The student must have obtained a "B" average at the end of the Fall semester, to be eligible to receive the second \$5,000* award that will be applied to tuition for the Spring semester upon **verification of grades and request for distribution submitted to Mrs. Denison by the student (NOT PARENT) by Friday, January 19, 2024. Official transcript is not required; screenshot of grades is fine. Before applying, the student should verify with the financial aid office at their college/university that acceptance of this scholarship will not reduce their overall financial aid package for the remaining years.**
