

### **Case Statement**

Clearwater Central Catholic, a premier college-preparatory high school in the Diocese of St. Petersburg, has continued a more than 58-year history of dedication to traditional Catholic values, a rigorous academic curriculum, and extensive co-curricular programs. Built in 1962 to educate around 150 students, CCC now endeavors to provide approximately 560 students with a Christ-centered, values-based academic environment in which they are encouraged to pursue levels of higher education and other lifelong learning experiences.

## Project: Athletic Building Renovation & Girls Locker Room Facilities

Built in 1965, the current girls locker room facility was constructed at a time when the school had no competitive girls sports teams and just three athletic clubs for girls—cheerleading/pep, swimming, and tennis. Since then, CCC has built a highly competitive and well-respected girls athletic program with 12 teams—basketball, cheerleading, cross country, golf, lacrosse, beach volleyball, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, track and field, and volleyball—serving nearly three-fourths of our female students.

### Background

In 2008, the school conducted a comprehensive deferred maintenance study, followed by a Campus Master Plan in 2017 which considered the deferred maintenance needs of the campus with a space utilization study and programmatic needs of the entire campus. The most immediate identified needs led to the transformation of our campus with the demolition of three buildings and the construction of the Learning and building, Achievement Field House, Leadership Center and the Chapel of Saint Julie Billiart. These documents continue to guide us regarding projects that still need to be completed.



### The Project

In 2020, a small committee was convened to review and amend the needs assessment that was done in the Master Plan of 2017. In March 2020, Holmes Architects' contract (for the major project mentioned above) was amended to add the renovation of the center section of the Athletic Building (referred to as the 600 Building) to accommodate the needs of the female students at CCC. This renovation will create girls locker room facilities for sports teams and physical education classes, classroom and meeting spaces, shared offices, and equipment storage. During this process an assessment of the roof and HVAC needs for the entire building was also done and it was determined that the building's entire roof and HVAC system need to be replaced.
