It features a complimentary wine hour, with red or white wine plus hot toddies in the winter, in the lobby each evening from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.



A group dinner at a restaurant close to the hotel will be planned for the evening of Wednesday, January 29th. The per person cost to cover the meal, taxes, and service charges/gratuities is expected to be approximately \$65 to \$70, excluding alcoholic beverages, and pre-payment will be required.
