The program was open to available non-depository Community Development Finance Institutions (CDFI) and Minority Depository Institutions (MDI) that serve Tennessee. CDFIs are mission-driven financial institutions that provide credit and financial services to underserved markets and populations who have been certified by the U.S. Department of Treasury.
