Structure and Goals of the Young Playwrights Institute:

Enrollment of six young people, ages 13 – 18 years. Enrollment Fee: \$ 100 per student for the six week workshop.

Instructor playwright Tom Moran will teach the fundamentals of script writing for the stage, providing individual coaching. The students will each create a ten-minute, original play. Participating students will have the opportunity to voice each other's dialogue during the writing process.
