Obstetrics and Gynecology Central Intake Going LIVE Soon!

1. Go-Live Target Date: June 2024

- All Obstetrics and Gynecology referrals for Thunder Bay Specialists will be received via Central Intake
- Our team will circulate the revised surgical referral form (CS-1062) and a NEW Obstetrics Referral Form. Thank you to all Primary Care Providers who supported the review of the new OB Form.
- Note: A detailed letter can be sent in lieu of the program Form provided the letter contains all the necessary information required for a complete referral.
- Please include relevant diagnostic reports, and attach the CPP Health Profile with current medication list from your EMR.

2. What will happen to faxes not sent to the OB/Gyne Central Intake?

• Faxes sent direct to surgeon will be returned to the requestor accompanied by a face sheet with instructors on how to refer to the OB or Gyne Central Intake.

3. What if the referral has missing information?

- Please try to provide as much relevant information as possible.
- If basic information required for proper triage is not complete, the referral will be returned with a face sheet identifying the missing components.

<u>Please note:</u> All Obstetricians, Gynaecologists and Family Doctor Obstetrics Providers are part of the OB/Gyne Central Intake. Requests for first available or a specific Provider will be honoured. Midwifery is not part of the Central Intake.
