Grants are targeted to specific, current needs of the poor, above and beyond available resources. Preferred interest areas are: rental/housing assistance, utility assistance, food, clothing, transportation, baby/children needs, and medical.

Grant Award Requirements:

- A Conference must be Aggregated and the District Council must be Instituted.
- If you have received a grant within the last 3 years, you are not eligible to apply.
- Grant funds are expected to be exhausted within 6 months.
- A Grant report is due within 6 months outlining in detail how the funds were used.

Please note: Your Friends of the Poor[®] Grant Application will not be considered unless all the application requirements are completed using the most recent version of the application, which is August 13, 2019, and emailed to the National Council by the due date.
