

## **COVID-19 POLICY FOR BANNERMAN ISLAND TOURS.**

New York State Parks does not require masks when you are outside in a New York State Park at this time. Proof of vaccination is not required for regular tour events. Proof of vaccination and a negative COVID-19 test with-in three days is required for all special events where you will be seated for long periods of time next to another person, such as a movie, play, dinner or wedding. At this time, Masks are required to be worn while seated in an audience, by all patrons. Everyone must wear a mask when they enter the Bannerman Family Residence. And in all interior buildings.

### **Proof of Vaccination Required for all Special Events on Bannerman Island**

- Patrons will need to be fully vaccinated in order to attend a performance , movie, the Farm Fresh Dinners, and weddings, must show proof of vaccination with a valid ID before they get on the Estuary Steward at the Beacon Waterfront dock.
- “Fully vaccinated” means the performance/movie/wedding/event date you are attending must be: at least 14 days after your second dose of an FDA or WHO authorized two dose COVID-19 vaccine, or at least 14 days after your single dose of an FDA or WHO authorized single dose COVID-19 vaccine.
- The only exception to the above will be guests under the age of 12, or those who need reasonable accommodations due to a medical condition or sincerely held religious belief that prevents vaccination. Patrons under 12 and those who need reasonable accommodations due to a medical condition or sincerely held religious belief must provide proof of at least one of the following: negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of the performance start time, or negative COVID-19 antigen test taken within 6 hours of the performance start time. Home tests are not accepted.

#### **Eligible Proof at this Time includes:**

- Vaccination Card
- Photo (on smartphone) or photo copy of vaccination card
- Excelsior Pass

In addition to providing proof of vaccination (or negative test result, as applicable) in accordance with these protocols, all guests must present a government-issued photo ID such as a driver's license or passport (patrons younger than 18 may present a school photo ID). If you forget your proof, you will not be admitted to the event. We suggest that you put a picture of your proof on your phone.

### **Bannerman Island Tours on the Estuary Steward**

Currently, masks are not required while you are on The Estuary Steward. The Steward is an outdoor vessel with a roof and open sides for plenty of air. Feel free to wear your mask while you are on the boat. Please note: COVID-19 policies are subject to change depending on the threat levels of COVID-19.
