Dracula on Bannerman Island

The Broadway version of Dracula comes to Bannerman Island. The original production of Dracula opened on the 5th of October in 1927 at the Fulton Theatre in New York City. The Broadway production starred the then-obscure Hungarian actor, Bela Lugosi in his first major English-speaking role. He would later reprise the role of Dracula in the cult classic horror film in 1931. After 60 years, Frank Langella would star as Dracula in the Broadway revival in 1977. The show was a hugh success.

Theatre on the Road's director Frank Marquette, presented a different version of Dracula by Crane Johnson on Bannerman Island to sell out crowds in both 1998 and 1999!

For the Bannerman 2022 Theatrical Season, Mr. Marquette returns to Bannerman Island with the original version of the Dracula dramatized by Dean Hamilton and Joan Balderston.
