Welcome Back, Parents & Students! Find important details for returning to campus below.

Campus-Specific Plan:

Parents that have not already read the Holy Spirit Campus Specific Plan emailed on July 17th, need to do so. There, you will find details about: masks, arrival and dismissal, morning care, lunch, PE, outdoor play, and Mass.

Parent Orientation:

This year, our Parent Orientation will be virtual. Mrs. Foley will send an email to all families the first week of August. On August 10th, classroom teachers will send an email to parents that includes a link to a video of the teacher. Also on August 10th, the distance learners and their parents will be invited to the school to pick up supplies, meet their teacher, and receive a copy of classroom procedures. On August 11th, the parents and students of K4, K5, and those new to MCPS will be invited to the school to meet their teacher and receive a copy of classroom procedures. Parents of distance learners, all K4, all K5, and students new to MCPS will be contacted for an appointment time to visit the school. Returning traditional learners will receive a copy of classroom procedures on the first day of school.

Distance Learners- Mass:

2nd-6th grade distance learners may attend Mass, accompanied by a parent or parent designee, on Thursdays 9:30-10:15. K4-1st grade will be notified of the date and time of their monthly Mass. If parents of K4, K5, or 1st grade distance learners would like for their child to attend the Mass, a parent or parent designee must attend with them.

School Photos

Individual school photos will be taken on Thursday, August 20th. All students should be in their Mass Day uniform. These photos will be used for the yearbook. Proofs will be sent home in September with an order form so that parents can order if they choose to do so. Parents of distance learners will be contacted as to the time their child's photo will be taken.
