Welcome Back, Parents & Students! Find important details for returning to campus below.

School Supplies:

This year we will once again have pre-packaged supplies for your children. The fee has already been included in your tuition, so there is no need to write another check or fight the crowds in the stores. The supplies will be delivered to the school and given to your child on the first day. You will still need to purchase a book-bag. Those choosing the blended learning option will be given a time to come to the school prior to the first day to pick up supplies and books.

Parent Orientation:

This year, for obvious reasons, we are going virtual with our Parent Orientation Night. On Monday, August 10th, you will receive an email from your child's teacher. There will be an attachment of forms or pertinent information that you may need, but there will also be a link to a video from the teacher. We hope this delivery method will serve to answer all of your back-to-school questions.

Sneak Peek for K4/K5 and New Students:

One of our biggest challenges this year will be to "check our parents at the door." One part of our Safe at School plan states that we cannot have visitors in the school. In order to alleviate the first day jitters of our new and youngest students, we will schedule a time for them to come have a quick "sneak peek" at their classrooms. They will also be able to meet their teachers and know where to go on the first day. The classroom teachers will be contacting all of the K4, K5, and new students in grades 1-6 in order to set up a time to visit. These visits will take place on the day before school starts, August 11th.

Distance/Blended Learners:

Those parents who are choosing distance learning for the first quarter will soon be contacted by their child's teacher. They will be setting up times for you to come to school to pick up supplies and books. There will also be enough time for you and your child to meet the teacher and to answer any questions you may have about distance learning. These meetings will be scheduled on the afternoon of Monday, August 10th.
