Multifactor authentication using credential analysis and identity proofing	NO	Single-factor authentication
Tamper-sealed notarized documents	NO	Documents not required to be electronic and will usually be paper with wet signatures. Electronic documents not required to be tamper-sealed
System security sufficient to prevent unauthorized interference with remote notarial act	NO	No requirements for security of systems used to conduct or record notarial act
RON notary must keep secure electronic journal of the notarial act, including evidence of signer's ID and backup of recording	NO	Notaries are not required to keep an electronic journal or a copy of signer's ID
Recording must be kept for minimum of 7 years, unless otherwise stipulated in state law	YES	Attorneys/notaries must keep recording for 10 years
