

What you should know before you go.

Before you purchase your ticket or head to the event, it is important to understand the health guidelines and entry requirements King County has adopted to ensure the safe return of live events. Below, you will find the information you need regarding new COVID-19 event protocols.

What is a Health Check?

Health Checks are safety protocols instituted by the venue to help reduce attendee exposure to COVID-19. The Roofing Contractors Association of Washington does not set or control Health Check guidelines. While specific requirements vary across different counties throughout Washington State – King County Mandates: proof of full vaccination against COVID-19, proof of a negative COVID-19 diagnostic test result prior to entering the event, or a rapid onsite COVID-19 test.

Is the Roofing Contractors Association of Washington requiring proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 diagnostic test for entry?

No, the RCAW does not set or control Health Check guidelines. King County is mandating venues to require proof of full vaccination against COVID-19, proof of a negative COVID-19 diagnostic test result prior to entering the event, or a rapid onsite COVID-19 test. I have received my first COVID-19 vaccination dose, will my first dose vaccination card be accepted at entry?

King County is mandating proof of full vaccination for entry, so the last vaccination dose needs to be administered at least two weeks prior to the event date. If you are not fully vaccinated a negative COVID-19 test will be required within 48-72 hours prior to the event.

Who will check vaccination status or negative COVID-19 diagnostic test at the entry?

The venue will designate personnel to check vaccination cards and/or negative COVID-19 diagnostic test results.

Will I have to wear a mask?

Depending upon local health departments and government guidelines, the venue may either require or encourage guests to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status. For those events where masks are required, all attendees - regardless of vaccination status - will be expected to always wear a mask, except while actively eating or drinking. For events where masks are encouraged, all attendees - regardless of vaccination status - will be encouraged to wear a mask except while actively eating or drinking.

Will event staff follow the same Health Check protocol as attendees?

The venue will require venue staff, vendors and concessionaires to follow the same onsite Health Check requirements as attendees.
