LIVE BY FAITH

ASK BEFORE LESSON

1. What is faith?
2. When did you place your faith in Christ?
3. How does your life look different now that you follow Christ?
4. What does it mean to walk with the Spirit?
5. Read Galatians 3:10-14. What does this tell you about our faith?

ASK AFTER LESSON

1. What does Paul mean when he says those who live by the law are under the curse?
2. How do law and faith function differently in God's plan?
3. How does Jesus redeem us *from* the curse, not just *forgive* us?
4. How does believing you are fully redeemed change the way you see yourself?
5. What does it look like to live as someone who is blessed, not cursed?
6. How can relying on rules or performance subtly creep into your faith?
7. What would it look like this week to live by faith instead of fear or pressure?
8. How will you do things differently this week, keeping your focus that the Spirit walks with you?

STANDING FIRM

This week, the challenge is to pray for one another. You will have an opportunity to write your name on a wristband at Youth Group. Then you will take another band with someone else's name on it and wear it. Every time you see that wristband with someone's name on it, pray for them.
