Northminster Church took their first group of High School Youth to Montreat in the summer of 1999. Since that time, over a 100 youth and adults have journeyed to Montreat Youth Conferences. In 2009, the first group went to the Montreat Middle School Conference now held at Maryville, College in Tennessee. Laurie Bass was one of the adult leaders who took the first group of Northminster Youth to Montreat. Laurie was traveled with a group to Colorado for Montreat West in 2001 and served as Support Staff Member for the Omega Conference Planning Team in 2006. Laurie was an advocate for all things Montreat and she was loved by all the Youth she knew. The Montreat Scholarship in her memory helps continue NPCs Montreat traditions for our Youth today.

The Session of NPC approved the scholarship in 2011 and the first awards were made in 2012. Full and partial scholarships for the High School Conference and Montreat Middle School Conference are offered with some preference given for those attending the for the first time. The Selection Committee is comprised of members of Laurie's family and other church members. Selections are made from applications received by the established deadline. Recipients are chosen based on service both to NPC and our local community as well their vision for sharing their Montreat experience with others.
