Who We Can Vaccinate

- **Children 18 and under who:**
 - Have no insurance for immunizations
 - Have Medical Assistance or BadgerCare
 - Are Native American or Alaska Native
- **Adults 19 and older who do not have insurance, only Covid and Flu.**

Accessing Your Immunization Records

- If you were vaccinated in Wisconsin, you can access your vaccination record using the Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR).
- To access your record, you'll need to provide your name and date of birth. You'll also need to provide your social security number **OR** Medicaid ID **OR** Health Care Member ID.

COVID-19	✓	✓
DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, and acellular pertussis)	✓	✗
Flu (influenza; Oct-Jun)	✓	✓
Hepatitis A or B	✓	✗
Hib (<i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b)	✓	✗
HPV (human papillomavirus)	✓	✗
Meningococcal ACWY (or B upon request)	✓	✗
MMR (measles, mumps, and rubella)	✓	✗
Pneumococcal	✓	✗

Polio	✓	✗
Rotavirus	✓	✗
RSV (for infants and high-risk toddlers; Oct-Mar)	✓	✗
Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis)	✓	✗
Varicella (chicken pox)	✓	✗
