Gynecological Cancer Awareness Month: Preventive Services Data

September is National Gynecological Cancer Awareness Month, making this a key time to highlight an important feature within our tools that can help providers view the results of their patients' life-saving cervical cancer screenings.

Preventive Services data—now including Cervical Cancer Screening notifications—are available in Population Explorer. Screening for cervical cancer is vital in early detection efforts. These alerts enable care teams to proactively identify patients who have completed preventive screenings or may be due for preventive screenings, helping ensure patients are up-to-date on their recommended screenings.

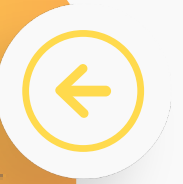
The Preventive Services section displays notifications in green and provides detailed information including screening category, procedure codes, results, facility names, and dates. Each notification links directly to source documents in the Clinical Information tool, streamlining your workflow.

By providing direct access to timely information regarding patient screening statuses, CRISP is empowering providers to close information gaps and hopefully make a difference in early detection and prevention.

Women screened within 3 years prior to diagnosis have:

83% lower risk of nonlocalized cancer

48% lower risk of localized cancer

What's New With CRISP

Annual Participant Survey Review

CRISP conducted its annual participant survey and received 514 responses. Overall, users were satisfied with CRISP; 76% rated their experience as satisfied or very satisfied, and many free responses praised the value and importance of our services. The main takeaway was the specific InContext enhancements users wanted: a way to find recently searched patient ;

new medication reconciliation and hospitalization timelines views; and keyword searching improvements. We appreciate our users' input and will continue using it to guide future improvements.

Displaying the Medicaid ID provides a unique patient identifier, helping reduce the risk of duplicate records and patient misidentification across healthcare systems and organizations. The Medicaid ID in the CRISP helps ensure healthcare providers have the information they need to deliver timely and effective care to Medicaid members.

Diabetes Prevention and Control & Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Length of Stay (LOS)
