OVER-THE-COUNTER HOME COVID TESTS

Many of you have asked about using home tests as proof of a positive COVID test. This is not possible because Misericordia is required to report all of the testing that is done on campus and received from staff. The tests that are reported must have at least two identifying factors, such as your name and birthdate; therefore home tests cannot be accepted as reportable COVID testing results.

With the rise of Omicron-variant COVID cases, **the CDC has recommended wearing N95s and KN95s as the best face protection against COVID transmissions**. While cloth and surgical masks continue to offer more protection than no mask at all, they have found N95s and KN95s to be the most effective.
