## SELF-SCREENING NOW BEING IMPLEMENTED AT THE START OF WORK

The most recent guidance from IDPH indicates that it is no longer necessary to take the temperature of employees prior to entering the workplace. Due to this change, we are moving to self-screening by area, your Supervisor or Director will inform you of where this will take place for your area or department. Every employee will still be expected to review the Screening Tool and sign in at the beginning of the workday. Additionally, every employee is expected to be aware of potential symptoms of COVID and refrain from coming to work if you are symptomatic.
