METHODOLOGY

On Sep. 26 2019 and Sep. 29-Oct. 2, 2019, TP Research conducted an IVR survey of 692 likely 2020 Primary Election voters throughout California's 50th Congressional District. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2020 Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/- 4% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

Darrell Issa, a Republican, is a former senior member of Congress. Serving as Chairman of the House Oversight committee Issa championed Trump's agenda, launched investigations into the Obama administration, and is running to bring strong leadership to fight against the liberal Pelosi agenda. Issa promises to end illegal immigration by securing the border, make California more job friendly and take care of our vets.

Carl DeMaio, a Republican and former San Diego councilman is a proven reformer with a track record of using his voice on the radio to fight against local and state tax increases such as the gas tax recall. On the San Diego City Council DeMaio fought against Unions and worked to reform the broken pension system. He pledges to shake up congress to fight unfair tax hikes, cut wasteful spending and secure the border.

Ammar Campa Najjar, a Democrat, worked in the Obama administration and will fight for universal healthcare, jobs and small businesses, more environmental protection, and will crack down on the gun violence epidemic facing our nation. Ammar is endorsed by nearly every Democratic member of Congress is California as well as local Democratic clubs.
