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All Forward to Monterey

- While we are disappointed that our Sparks Regional was cancelled, everyone agrees it was the best decision. The Nugget was tremendously accepting of our decision and we settled out of that contract at no cost to the District and another year's guarantee for use of the hotel. Much appreciation to all that spent time planning and working. We were much better prepared to start our efforts for Monterey Clambake Regional, which will run from January 3 to 9, 2022.



- As we approach Monterey, we again created a schedule with events targeting our players with under 3000 Masterpoints. Look closely and you'll see three days of "mid-flight" play, coupled with Gold Rush and 199^{er} pairs. Hospitality breaks will be turned into Mask Breaks if and when masks are required for indoor activities.
