Day 5 Monday, April 19th

Overnight: [Arles, Maison Volver](#) (2 nights)

Arles ~ Arles is a historical symphony. Founded as a metropolis of classical Rome, the city preserves echoes of emperors and gladiators in its monuments. The Arena and the Amphitheatre, both UNESCO World Heritage sites, still host traditional fairs and bullfights, as they did in the first century. But Arles is also the city where **Vincent van Gogh** created more than 300 masterpieces in just 15 months. Here, between February 1888 and May 1889, the Dutch genius captured Provence in passionate colours. Today, the places where Van Gogh placed his easel are marked so you can follow in his artistic footsteps. In the afternoon, a **walking tour in Avignon** – The Papal Jewel of Provence: Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site, Avignon was for centuries one of France's main artistic centres. The Papal Palace, built in 1335, dominates the city with its majestic Gothic architecture.

Day 6 Tuesday, April 20th

Day 7 Wednesday, April 21st

After breakfast, departure from Arles to Marseille, France's oldest city and one of the most vibrant in the Mediterranean. We will begin our visit at the majestic Basilica of Notre-Dame de la Garde, situated at the highest point of the city. From this emblematic sanctuary, affectionately known by Marseillais as "La Bonne Mère", we will enjoy stunning panoramic views of the port, nearby islands, and the infinite blue of the Mediterranean. Next, continue to the historic Vieux-Port (Old Port), the heart of Marseille for over 2,600 years. We will stroll among traditional

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boats, elegant yachts, lively terraces, and local markets, discovering the maritime and multicultural essence that has made Marseille a unique city.

After lunch, we will take a short ferry ride to the legendary **Château d'If**, the island fortress immortalised by Alexandre Dumas in the novel **The Count of Monte Cristo**. Its ancient walls, its fascinating history, and spectacular views over the Mediterranean coast make this visit an unforgettable experience. At the end of the day, return to Marseille and have free time to enjoy the atmosphere of this captivating port city.

Marseille is passion, history and vitality in its purest form. We will begin our tour at the Vieux Port (Old Port), a vibrant market where ships have docked for over a thousand years, where the aroma of fresh fish and maritime traditions remain alive. From there, we will ascend to the Basilica of Notre-Dame de la Garde, which rises 154 meters above the port like a vigilant guardian. This architectural gem of the 19th century, built on the foundations of a 16th-century fortress that in turn expanded a medieval chapel, shines with colored marble, exquisite Byzantine mosaics and murals showing ships sailing under the protection of La Bonne Mère (The Good Mother).

Discovering the Treasures of the Côte d'Azur

This morning, we depart on one of the **most spectacular routes** of the trip, following the Mediterranean coast towards the French Riviera. We will have time to stroll leisurely and enjoy lunch in an incomparable setting.

In the afternoon, we will arrive in **Nice, the elegant capital of the French Riviera**. Before boarding, we will enjoy a final stroll along the famous Promenade des Anglais, admiring the turquoise waters of the Mediterranean and the lively atmosphere of this emblematic coastal city. Farewell to our coastal tour as **we transfer to the port and embark on our cruise**, beginning a new stage of this extraordinary Mediterranean adventure.

Portofino is a fishing village on the Italian Riviera coastline. Its pastel-coloured houses, luxury boutiques and seafood restaurants surround its Piazzetta, a small cobbled square overlooking the harbour & super-yachts. A short walk takes you up to the Church of St. George, a church with a cool, plain interior, dramatically situated on the narrow neck of the Portofino headland. As a lookout point and probably a site of religious significance, the spot dates back thousands of years.

Propriano - Corsica, France

The coastal town of Propriano is found on the south-west coast of Corsica, about halfway between the major towns of Ajaccio and Bonifacio. The harbour contains a fascinating combination of exclusive yachts and modest fishing boats, and is worth a visit for some of the best views of the town. The town centre has plenty of luxury shops, cafes and bars to enjoy.

Alghero - Sardinia, Italy

Overnight: Clipper Ship

Alghero is the main resort in northwestern Sardinia and one of its most beautiful medieval cities. Its bustling historic centre is packed with excellent bars and restaurants, making it a great place to hang out. It is also ideally positioned to explore the beaches of the nearby Riviera del Corallo. Interestingly, a form of medieval Catalan is still spoken even though the Iberians left three centuries ago.

Calvi - Corsica, France

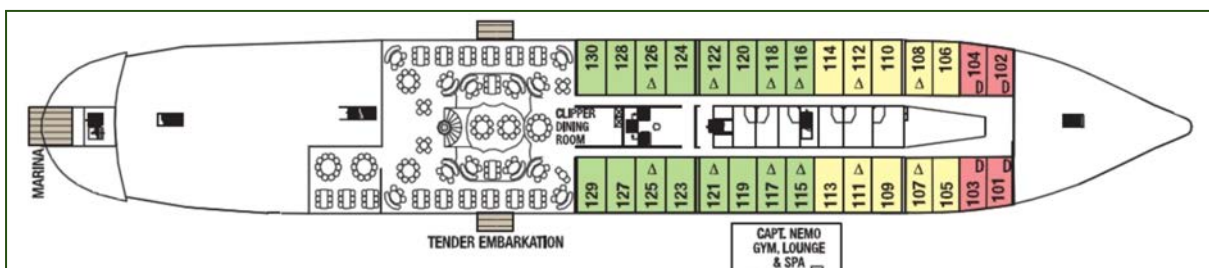
Main Deck
