

WOOD BADGE COURSE



Purpose of Wood Badge

The primary purpose of the Wood Badge experience is simple—to strengthen Scouting in our units, districts, and council. Every scouting youth deserves a well-trained leader. Wood Badge provides dedicated Scouters with the concepts, tools, and methods needed to be effective leaders.

Attending Wood Badge will make your Scouting job easier. Attendees gain an in-depth understanding of the skills of leadership. The skills you learn will help you become a more effective leader in Scouting, your career, your family, and your community life.

As a result of attending Wood Badge you will:

- Become familiar with team leadership concepts
- Experience the stages of team development and practice leadership approaches appropriate for each stage
- Have a great deal of FUN in the company of interesting, like-minded friends
- Develop a renewed commitment to provide Scouting with the best possible leadership

Course Fee: \$250

Early Registration: \$225 (if paid by June 15, 2018)

Late Registration: \$275 (if paid after July 3, 2018)

Fee covers program and training materials, food and lodging for both weekends, two participant T-shirts, and one Wood Badge Recognition Kit (upon completion of the training program).

REFUND POLICY: The \$50 deposit is non-refundable. Refunds requested prior to 30 days before the course begins receive 100% refund, less the deposit; 29 to 7 days receives 50% refund, less the deposit; 7 days or less and "No Shows" will forfeit 100% of fees.
