Sacramento's first Domestic Violence shelter, designed specifically for Muslim women

Amanah House provides a safe and private home to survivors of domestic violence. A home where the women will be treated with dignity and respect.

Children up to a certain age may come with their mothers. The shelter empowers women to overcome their previous circumstances by providing the tools, peer support counseling, and community connections needed to aspire towards an upward mobility.



Amanah House has been serving women and helping those who may be:

- Physically, emotionally or verbally abused
- Controlled or abused financially, legally, spiritually, or in other ways
- Suffered from human trafficking

Staff can assist and support in multiple languages, including Arabic, Dari, English, Pashto, and Urdu.
