- ◆ Wednesday, August 16, 8:30 AM—2:15 PM
- ◆ There is NO bus service on this day.
- ◆ Day begins at 8:30 AM in Mulcahey Gym. Please drop off your son or daughter to Bardin between 8:00-8:25 AM on the front steps. Pick up is along the circle drive at 2:15 PM.
- ◆ Freshmen must be in uniform and bring iPads, charged and ready to go.
