

SHANTYTOWN is a program designed to create an understanding of modern day homelessness as it exists in our community. We will sleep outside overnight at Bardin—a form of action that is designed not to simulate homelessness, but to bring awareness to the issues of poverty by listening, learning, and asking questions about homelessness as it exists today.
