Accessory Building Permit Requirements

Permit Specifics- Ordinance 14.04.001

- 1. Size
 - a. Must be permitted if over 200 square feet.
 - b. Cannot be attached to principal building. Will then fall under principal building requirements.
 - c. Maximum building floor area of 600 square feet or 50% of the floor area of the principal building. (Whichever is greater)
- 2. Setbacks
 - a. Not allowed in minimum front yard setback.
 - b. If adjoined to the alley right-of-way, no setback shall be required.
 - c. A minimum setback of 5 feet from either/or the side or rear lot line shall be maintained.

Documents Needed-

- 1. Permit application through online portal- Online Link
- 2. Submit plans that outline the following: (See attached for example)
 - a. Site plan that includes property lines and principal building
 - b. Dimensions of structure
 - c. Setbacks labeled from property line and principal building
 - d. Must be drawn to scale
- 3. Fee can be paid online through portal or at City Hall, 302 Main Street

Separate Permits-

- 1. Electrical
- 2. Plumbing
- 3. Mechanical

NOTE: Accessory buildings may not be used as a secondary, livable space in addition to the principal building.

^{*}See Master Fee Schedule for pricing. Permits required depend on the extent of the project.
