CHRISTMAS WITH DIGNITY – TOY STORES

What is this ministry about? Rather than just giving away toys – we put together special toy stores in Kingsburg, London, and Traver. Parents sign up – pay a nominal fee of \$5.00 per child (or less if we feel it is warranted) – and then can shop themselves for brand new toys and clothing for each of their children. That's where the dignity comes in. Just like you, these parents want to provide for their own children. This allows them to do that, by giving them an opportunity for a hand-up, not a handout. We bundle the gifts according to age and gender – each bundle being valued at \$35.00 – or more. The gifts are obtained through donations of new unwrapped toys, or financial gifts to KCAPS. We take the designated funds and go shopping, for thousands of dollars of toys and clothing.



Although it's October we are already in the planning stages for these important, BIG, successful events. In past years we have had **500 - 700 children** a year blessed through this ministry. **Stimulus money is gone and lots of these families fell through the cracks anyway. We know lots of kids are still stressed – our counselors are working with them. You can help!**

We never know the actual number of children to anticipate until the signup period is over. During the signup process we do our best to discern between families who truly need this ministry and those who may wish to take advantage.



Every year our staff also identifies children we believe need a special boost and some positive attention in their lives. These children come from families who did not sign up to participate. Typically, their parents for one reason or another aren't functioning well in life, and their children are reaping the consequences. Toys are selected and delivered by staff or one of our local pastors.

Traditionally, our toys have been donated primarily by local churches and through the Kingsburg Elementary schools. Frankly we feel the schools have enough on their plates, so we are not collecting through the schools this year.

We don't want to leave out a single deserving child! **Please let us know now how you plan to help.**
