WILDFIRE & CLIMATE

- Thinning forests reduces wildfire risk; removed trees can be used for mass timber
- Less reliance on old-growth forests!

FOREST MANAGEMENT

- Can use small/medium sized trees from unhealthy forests
- Links forest restoration to economic value

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- Prefabricated mass timber allows fast, efficient home construction
- Helps address the housing crisis with urgency & affordable homes.

JOBS FOR THE REGION

- Mass Timber is taking off in the Pacific Northwest creating jobs from forest to factory to construction
- Provides living-wage jobs, especially for marginalized communities

To making housing using wood in smarter, more sustainable ways.

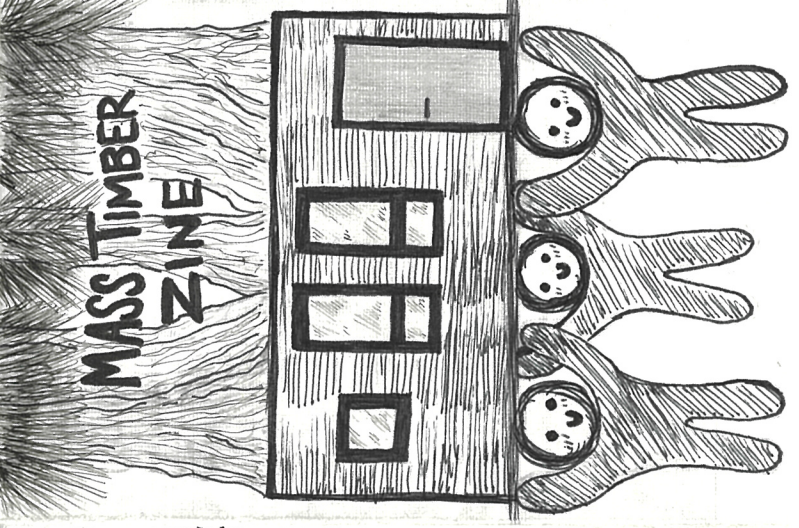
IT'S ALL ABOUT TEAMWORK

Mass Timber is a type of engineered wood made by gluing & pressing smaller pieces of wood together to create bigger, stronger wood products than regular lumber.

PAGE 5 & 6: Frame in pages 5 & 6 is made up of laminated panels which are then used to create modular homes.

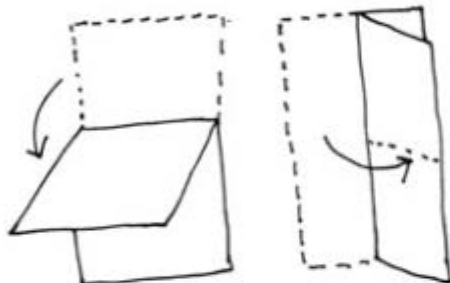

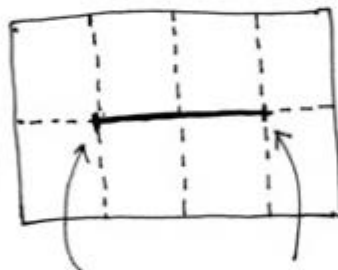
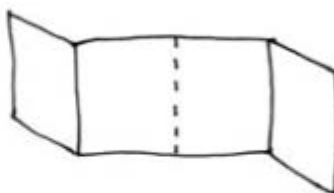
How to fold the pamphlet.

Print out pamphlet
and copy several times

step 1
Take one 8 1/2 x 11 sheet
sheet of paper
Fold sheet in half
both lengthwise and
widthwise.

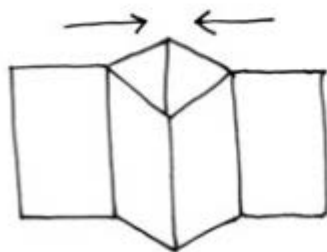


step 2
Fold paper lengthwise
then fold the ends in
like this.

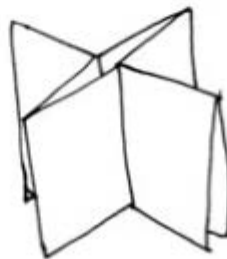


Cut from here to here.

step 3
Open up the center
push in ends like this



and flatten like
this.



step 4
Flatten into book
shape.
