Gov. Lamont issued Executive Order No. 7G

- Postponement of presidential primary to June 2.
- Suspension of non-critical court operations and associated requirements.
- Further clarification of limits on restaurants, bars and private clubs allowing the sale of sealed containers of alcohol to accompany food for off-site consumption.
- Suspending operations of barbershops, hair salons, nail salons, spas, tattoo or piercing parlors and related businesses.
- Medicaid telehealth flexibility.
- Temporary suspension of in-person investigative visits regarding reports of elder abuse.
- Extension of time for disclosure of investigation results.

Press Reports:

- The state has activated a framework for donations of PPE's from members of the public, businesses, and philanthropic organizations.
- Gov. Lamont announced today that beginning Monday, 3/23/2020 at 8:00 A.M., all non-essential businesses should allow employees to stay home or face possible fines. Banks, liquor stores, supermarkets, pharmacies, vehicle repair shops, large construction projects and major defense contractors such as Sikorsky Aircraft should remain open, but with reduced staffs.

- Griffin Health has been approved by the Connecticut Department of Public Health to provide a drive-up collection facility for COVID-19 testing.
- Tax Day was officially moved from 4/15/2020 to 7/15/2020.
