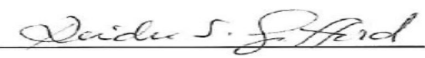

RE: CMAP COVID-19 Response – Bulletin 2: Laboratory Testing Coverage

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has developed two Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes that can be used by laboratories to bill for certain COVID-19 diagnostic tests to help increase testing and track new cases.

Effective for dates of service **March 18, 2020** and forward, laboratory providers must use one of the following HCPCS for the billing of COVID-19 diagnostic tests. Reimbursement for the tests will be set at the Medicare rate and the Laboratory fee schedule will be updated accordingly.

HCPCS	Description	Rate
U0001	2019 Novel Coronavirus Real Time RT-PCR Diagnostic Test Panel – <i>To be used for tests developed by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC)</i>	\$35.91
U0002	2019-nCoV Coronavirus, SARS-CoV-2/2019-nCoV (COVID-19) using any technique, multiple types or subtypes (includes all targets) – <i>To be used for non-CDC laboratory tests</i>	\$51.31

ICD-10-CM Coding

Providers should follow the CDC ICD-10-CM Official Coding Guidelines to ensure proper coding.
